Declaration

_____ (vendor/property name) declare the animals described above meet the following requirements-

- No lame, blind, injured, sick or substituted animals will be loaded on road transport to the loading facility.
- During transport to the authorised assembly depot no animals other than those described above were loaded.
- The livestock were born and raised in Australia.
- To the best of my knowledge, livestock sourced for export comply with Australian Food Safety requirements including standards for chemical residues or environmental contaminants.
- The animals are free from clinical evidence of any disease during the past 30 days in particular, ringworm, pinkeye, lumpy jaw and dermatophilosis.
- The livestock and the property for export have been free of any known outbreaks or clinical symptoms for at least six (6) months prior to shipment for the following diseases; Tetanus, Malignant Oedema, Blackleg, Pulpy Kidney, Black Disease, Bovine Cysticercosis, Intestinal Salmonella (Salmonellosis), Theileriasis, Hendra Virus
- The livestock and the property for export have been free of any known outbreaks or clinical symptoms for at least twelve (12) months prior to shipment for the following diseases; Infectious Pustular Vulvo-vaginitis (IPV), Anaplasmosis, Babesiosis, Botulism, Actinomycosis (Lumpy Jaw), Sporadic Bovine Encephalomyelitis, Trichophytosis (Ringworm), Contagious Ophthalmia (pinkeye), Dermatophilosis, Surra,
- The livestock and the property for export have been free of any known outbreaks or clinical symptoms for at least twenty-four (24) months prior to shipment for the following diseases: Bovine Genital Campylobacteriosis (Vibriosis) and Trichomoniasis
- All livestock and the property of origin showed no clinical signs or abattoir evidence of Enzootic Bovine Leucosis (EBL), Bluetongue, Mucosal Disease/Bovine Virus Diarrhoea (MD/BVD), Infectious Bovine Rhinotracheitis (IBR), 'Q' Fever, Haemorrhagic Septicaemia, Ephemeral fever, Bovine Malignant Catarrhal fever and Leptospirosis during the previous three (3) years.
- The animals and property have had no officially reported cases of Johne's Disease (Paratuberculosis) in the previous five (5) years.
- I further declare that the animals have never been fed with any kind of processed animal products excluding milk protein.
- The animals for export originate from an area free from Anthrax for at least the previous 12 months prior to export.
- The animals for export originate from properties which are officially free from Tuberculosis and Bovine Brucellosis, clinical Bluetongue
- The animals for export have been vaccinated against Botulism (buffalo to Indonesia only)
- I give permission for the relevant State Department to disclose animal health information relating to my property to a third party, for the purpose of the export of live animals that have resided on my property.
- The livestock to be exported are NLIS identified and registered on the NLIS database against this Property Identification Code (PIC) where they currently reside.
- Livestock comply with all relevant state/territory health and welfare legislation and national codes of practice regarding on-property management, sourcing and land transport according ASEL Standards 1 and 2. For copies of any codes, contact a Bondstock representative.
- No livestock are within a withholding period or Export Slaughter Interval for antibiotics. The livestock do not contain hormone growth promotant (HGP) residues at levels harmful to human health, as determined by Codex Alimentarius food safety standards.

Note : Commonwealth legislation provides that giving false or misleading information is an offence, with penalties up to five years imprisonment.
